

Register as a teacher using Prim20 as the roll number to access resources. Click on 'Unit' , then choose number 6. Scroll down to 'Poster'. Discuss the poster asking as many questions to illicit understanding and further discussion.

Digital poster (Story mode)

Play either the Story mode 1 (starters) or Story mode 2 (flyers), depending on the ability level.

Digital poster (Explore mode): Talk and discussion

Go to the Explore mode of the poster. Ask children the following questions, using the pen, spotlight and zoom tools to aid you:

- Look at the picture of the fire engine and the ambulance. What is the same and what is different?
- Name three things you would find on an ambulance.
- Point to the stethoscope. What is a stethoscope used for?
- What do you think first aid means? What would be in a first aid kit?
- What is the trolley for?
- Point to the picture at the top right-hand corner. What has this man got on his face? What do you think this is for? What do you think the paramedic is saying to the man?
- Look at the bottom middle picture. Can you name these objects?
- What is the hose used for?
- Look at the bottom left picture. What is this girl's job? Can you guess what the different pieces of equipment she has might be used for?

What's wrong?

Read the following sentences to the children. Ask them to identify what is wrong, justifying

what they say, and giving you a corrected version of the sentence.

- 1. An ambulance brings healthy people to the park.
- 2. Ambulances are driven by teachers.
- 3. Paramedics are people who have been trained to help sick animals.
- 4. The trolley in the ambulance is used to bring patients shopping.
- 5. There is a camera on top of the ambulance.
- 6. Firefighters are very scared.
- 7. Firefighters start fights in the street.
- 8. Firefighting is a very safe job.
- 9. A firefighter wears a woolly hat to protect their head.
- 10. Firefighters wear shorts and tee-shirts when putting out fires.

Ask your child to decide what **emergency service** is needed, what **equipment** is needed, and **how they can help**.

1. Emergency A

The local library is on fire. There might be people inside.

What emergency service should you call? What equipment will they need? How can you help?

2. Emergency B

A football player has hurt his leg during a game. He can't stand up.

3. Emergency C

An elderly lady has fallen on the pavement and dropped all her shopping. She can't get up.

4. Emergency D

The fire alarm has gone off in school and smoke has been seen in the staff room.

You could ask your child the following questions. - Do you think that children get confused if they see a lot of advertisements for different toys? - Do the advertisements help you? - Do they help you make up your mind about Christmas, special times or birthdays? If they do, how do they help?
If not, how do you make up your mind?
Do you listen to what your friends say?
Do you listen to what your parents say?
Ask the children to think for a minute and decide what they believe is the best toy in the world.
Maybe they could draw and colour this toy into their orange copy.
